The Year Ahead: A 2026 Outlook for Industry and Regulation

As we move into 2026, the adhesives and sealants industry continues to face significant regulatory change. In GB, key developments include the evolution of UK REACH (including the Alternative Transitional Model, ATrM) and the implementation of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR).

A major concern is the cost impact of packaging EPR (pEPR) fees. Under the Recyclability Assessment Methodology (RAM), adhesive and sealant packaging is expected to be classified as "red" due to unavoidable residual contamination, resulting in higher fees. BASA is establishing a task force to gather evidence, assess member impact, and explore mitigation options (*see article on page 16*).

Ongoing delays to UK REACH legislation remain a serious issue, particularly for the long-term availability of key raw materials such as preservatives. Despite extensive industry engagement, the Government has extended deadlines by only one year, leaving continued uncertainty and making long-term planning difficult.

The Government's decision to indefinitely recognise CE marking for construction products provides short-term certainty, but raises questions over the future viability of UKCA marking and GB testing capacity.

In the EU, sustainability and product safety remain central, though the pace of change has slowed. "Stop-the-clock" measures will delay several proposals, including packaging classification under CLP, while consultations continue on the New Legislative Framework and Digital Product Passports.

BASA, working closely with FEICA, will continue to monitor developments, engage constructively, and support members through an increasingly complex regulatory landscape.

Exhibitions and conferences

The Handbook was published for the first BASA conference taking place in March to coincide with the 43rd AGM of the Association. Information on the presentations made at the conference will be available after the event, on the BASA Info Hub along with the minutes from the AGM.

BASA will also continue its support of CHEMUK at the NEC in May, where we will be presenting and leading a panel discussion session on the future opportunities for adhesives and sealants. Covering key growth areas of bio-based formulations, electric vehicles, smart materials and more.

Surfex takes place in June and BASA will again be leading discussion sessions focussing on complying with the legislative and regulatory changes affecting our industry.

Working Groups

Participation in BASA WG's offers an effective way to stay informed about the latest regulatory and technical developments affecting our industry. I strongly encourage members to consider volunteering. All meetings are held virtually, providing flexibility around time commitments, while those who engage more actively find the experience highly rewarding, supporting both personal professional development and the opportunity to contribute to, and influence, the direction of key industry topics. Further details on the available WG's can be found in the members' area of the BASA website.

Open Industry Forum

Face-to-face meetings remain crucial for developing working relationships, and we intend to hold one Open Industry Forum meeting on 6 October 2026 to enable our technical community to engage with colleagues in person.

Packaging for adhesives & sealants under EPR – why current scoring risks unintended damage

Summary

The UK's new Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) framework, particularly the household-focused recycling "traffic-light" system, does not reflect the realities of adhesives and sealants packaging. This sector relies on technical formats designed to contain reactive liquids, pastes and powders safely, often using multi-material structures or barrier layers. Current scoring risks penalising products not because they are poorly designed, but because they cannot fit the model used for ordinary consumer packaging. A more sector-appropriate approach is needed to support cost fairness and genuine carbon reduction.

Why the current traffic-light model is misaligned

Function-critical packaging

Cartridges, foil packs, lined tins, dual-component systems and laminated films are chosen for performance and safety. Simpler mono-materials often cannot provide the required protection or shelf life.

Contamination challenges

Residues from uncured or semi-reactive materials limit the viability of standard kerbside recycling.

Household-based testing

The RAM (Recycling Assessment Methodology) is built around consumer packaging flows. Most adhesive/sealant formats inherently fall outside these pathways and default to amber or red, despite being necessary for safe use.

Risk to sector and market

Cost increases

Red-category formats attract high fees, hitting SMEs and specialist manufacturers hardest.

Market distortion

Products that cannot be redesigned into "green tick" formats are penalised regardless of their actual environmental footprint.

Innovation diversion

Effort risks shifting toward chasing recyclability scores rather than improving durability, performance or lower-carbon chemistry.

Net-zero conflict

Lightweight or high-recycled-content formats may score poorly even when they have a better life-cycle carbon profile than heavier or reusable options.

What the sector needs

- A **tailored recyclability pathway** that recognises essential barrier layers, contamination issues, specialist industrial recycling routes and professional-only formats outside household waste streams.
- **Modulation based on carbon evidence**, not just household recyclability.
- **Recognition of take-back and specialist recycling schemes**, which currently score poorly simply because they bypass kerbside bins.
- **Realistic transition timelines** to allow for tooling, testing and regulatory validation.

Practical solutions

- Introduce an **"industrial technical packaging"** category.
- Accept **specialist recycling pathways** as compliant.
- **Weight fees using LCA evidence** to reward genuine carbon reductions.
- Establish an **industry-regulator working group** to align standards and support circular systems.

Call to Action

The sector supports EPR's aims, but the current model risks unfair penalties, poorer carbon outcomes and unnecessary costs.

A collaborative, sector-specific approach is essential to deliver both sustainability and a resilient UK/EU manufacturing base.

European Model Environmental Product Declarations (Model EPDs)

European Model EPDs demonstrate the environmental credentials of adhesives and sealants in construction

Sustainable development is of great significance in the construction industry. Increasingly, architects and green procurement bodies are demanding products that meet international sustainability standards. FEICA's position on the Construction Products Regulation can be read on the FEICA and BASA website. The review of the Construction Products Regulation (EU) No. 305/2011) included the requirement for sustainability, and Belgium and France have national legislation requiring Environmental Product Declarations (EPDs) for construction products with an environmental claim.

From 2016 to 2022, FEICA offered Model Environmental Product Declarations (Model EPDs), which could be used by construction products manufacturers to prove the environmental impact of their products. Therefore, the choice of adhesive and sealant products available to architects and green procurement bodies was significantly increased.

The expansion of the range of



products with Model EPDs gives SMEs improved access to a market that is otherwise available only to some and leads to significant cost and time savings for companies.

As Model EPDs are valid only for a maximum of 6 years, the 2016 versions were updated in 2022. FEICA, Industrieverband Klebstoffe (IVK), the European Federation for Construction Chemicals (EFCC) and Deutsche Bauchemie e.V. (DBC) undertook a joint project to revise and extend the Model EPDs, as well as to extend the scope for additional substances and formulations.

The European Model EPDs are available to FEICA Direct Company Members (DCMs), Affiliate Company Members (ACMs) and FEICA National Association Members (NAMs). They are valid across the whole of Europe (not limited to the EU). Turkey, is not included.





Published EPDs:

- Products based on POLYURETHANE (PU) or SILANE-modified polymer, group 1 to 4 (4 EPDs)
- Products based on POLYURETHANE, group 5 to 6 (2 EPDs)
- Dispersion-based products, group 1 to 4 (4 EPDs)
- SILICONE based products - group 1 to 3 (3 EPDs)
- Products based on EPOXY-resin, group 1 to 5 (5 EPDs)
- Modified mineral MORTARS, group 1 to 3 (3 EPDs)

The core EPD may be used by BASA members provided it has been proven that the respective product can be represented by this particular EPD.

FEICA has a guideline and a excel based calculation sheet available for BASA Members. This guideline, together with a template for a declaration of compliance, is available by clicking on the '[Request guideline](#)' link on their website.

Only authorised FEICA member companies (and members of FEICA National Associations like BASA) may use the guideline and the substance list to check the formulation and select an appropriate Model EPD.



The Challenge of the Same Chemical Compliance Dates for All Actors in the Supply Chain

The chemicals sector is facing increasingly crowded compliance calendars. New harmonised classifications under the CLP Regulation and REACH restrictions, including the microplastics restriction, are landing on the same compliance date, creating intense regulatory pressure.

While aligned deadlines may appear efficient, in practice they generate heavy workloads, uncertainty, and timing challenges across the supply chain — with downstream actors feeling the greatest strain.

The Domino Effect Down the Supply Chain

The biggest challenge is timing. Manufacturers often work on complex compliance changes up to the legal deadline, driven by the need to interpret new requirements, manage testing, or reformulate products. This leaves little time for those further down the chain to react.

Distributors, formulators, and end users rely on upstream suppliers for updated classifications, raw material data, and revised documentation and labels. When this information arrives late, downstream actors face an impossible race to update systems, labels, and regulatory submissions. The resulting delays increase the

risk of non-compliance, product shortages, or temporary market withdrawals, particularly in sectors with complex supply chains.

Operational and Market Consequences

Synchronised deadlines can create commercial distortions, disrupting competition and increasing market uncertainty when suppliers reach compliance at different times. Distributors may struggle to secure compliant materials, while manufacturers risk losing customers awaiting reformulated products and absorbing higher compliance costs.

Towards Smarter Implementation

There's a growing call for regulators to adopt a more staggered approach, introducing phased deadlines across the supply chain. Allowing time between manufacturer compliance and downstream implementation would support smoother transitions and improve compliance quality.

Simultaneous deadlines may appear tidy on paper, but they compress the compliance window for the entire supply chain. For downstream actors, it becomes a race against the clock — one few can afford to lose.

Packaging Waste: A Defining Challenge for Our Industry

Packaging waste is rapidly becoming one of the most significant challenges facing the adhesives and sealants industry. Regulatory pressure is increasing, costs are rising, and expectations around sustainability are tightening across both the UK and EU. These changes will not affect a small subset of businesses – they will have a direct impact on every sealant and adhesive manufacturer operating in the market.

Under the UK's Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) legislation, packaging classified as household waste will be subject to substantially higher fees, designed to cover the full net costs of collection, sorting, and disposal by local authorities.

Crucially for our sector, adhesive and sealant packaging will not qualify for reduced, "modulated" fees under the current framework. In parallel, the proposed EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) is expected to require all packaging placed on the EU market to be recyclable by 2030, introducing further design, material, and compliance challenges.

These are not abstract policy changes. Obligated businesses (those meeting the relevant turnover and tonnage thresholds) are already required to collect and report data on all packaging they place on the market, including B2B, commercial, and industrial packaging. This data collection obligation has been in place since 2023.

From October 2025, businesses will begin paying new waste management fees based on 2024 packaging data. While B2B packaging is expected to continue being managed through commercial waste streams and will not incur the new household waste fees, classification and interpretation remain areas of concern for many members.

At the same time, it is increasingly clear that packaging for adhesives and sealants presents challenges that differ fundamentally from those of everyday consumer products. Technical packaging must contend with chemical reactivity, shelf-life requirements, residual contamination, and limited end-of-life options. These realities mean that approaches suitable for

products such as shampoos or food packaging cannot simply be applied to our sector.

In response, BASA is launching the **Product Packaging Life Cycle Analysis Task Force**. This new working group has been established to ensure that future regulatory discussions and sustainability strategies affecting our industry are informed by robust, real-world evidence rather than assumptions.

The Task Force will:

- Gather and review existing Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) data to understand the true carbon impacts of different packaging formats and identify critical data gaps.
- Assess whether reuse, recycling, or refill systems genuinely deliver environmental benefits for adhesive and sealant products and;
- Clearly articulate why packaging for reactive, technical products must be treated differently within policy and regulatory frameworks.

This work will be essential in shaping BASA's engagement with policymakers and regulators in the UK and EU. However, its success depends on industry participation. Member input, whether through data sharing, technical expertise, or practical experience, is vital to ensuring that the unique realities of our sector are fully understood and represented.



This is a critical moment for our industry. Without clear, evidence-based input from manufacturers, there is a real risk that future packaging rules will be shaped by assumptions that do not reflect the technical realities of adhesives and sealants. BASA therefore strongly urges members to actively engage with the Product Packaging Life Cycle Analysis Task Force by contributing data, sharing practical experience, and participating in discussions.

Collective industry action is essential if we are to influence policy outcomes, manage future costs, and ensure that sustainability requirements are both achievable and meaningful for our sector.

The European adhesives and sealants (A&S) market

With much disruption and uncertainty in the marketplace today, having an accurate picture of the market remains to be more important than ever.

FEICA has published the ninth edition of the market study programme entitled 'The European Adhesives and Sealants Market', prepared by Smithers on behalf of FEICA, the Association of the European Adhesive and Sealant Industry.

This exclusive article provides an overview of the European market and the market in Great Britain.


European market

The European adhesives and sealants (A&S) market amounted to a combined volume of 4.64 million tonnes in 2024 with a value of €20.3 billion. Adhesives accounted for 83.5% share of the total volume in 2024 and 74.6% share of the value.

The volume demand for adhesives and sealants will increase in 2025 to an estimated 4.71 million tonnes, with the market value increasing to €20.7 billion.

The combined demand for adhesives and sealants in Europe is forecast to increase by 1.7% CAGR in volume between 2023 and 2030 to 5.16 million tonnes by the end of this period. The value is forecast to grow by 2.5% CAGR over the reporting period to result in a market of €23.6 billion. Although sealants have a smaller share of the European A&S market, their demand is forecast to grow at a slightly faster rate in volume than adhesives between 2025 and 2030.

Demand for adhesives and sealants has grown steadily since 2023 with markets starting to stabilise as energy prices and inflationary pressures gradually eased. Although the value has still grown at a faster rate than volume over the last two years, the rates of price increases have slowed. Container shortages and imbalances which were seen at the start of the pandemic recovery in 2021 continued to affect global shipping capabilities in 2024. Trade flows remained unpredictable and transportation costs increased for both shippers and carriers. Shipping costs have also been impacted by

higher fuel prices and increased compliance costs from new environmental regulations, as well as problems on the two key routes through the Suez and Panama Canals which led to delays and/or additional expense from having to divert to a longer route.

These logistics problems and the threats from US tariffs and heightened trade tensions in 2025 present some challenges to many businesses within the European adhesive and sealant industry. Some adhesive and sealant manufacturers are looking at options to source more materials from European suppliers, preferably ones in the same country. Just-in-time purchasing strategies have largely been abandoned and most A&S producers have at least two suppliers for key raw materials, one of which is preferably based in Europe. However, moving the production of raw materials back to Europe presents several major challenges, including high energy costs and greater regulation than in most other parts of the world.

Adhesive trends

Adhesives based on polymer dispersions & emulsions are the largest product group used in Europe with 45.4% share of volume demand in 2024. Reactive (polymerising) adhesives accounted for 19.3% of volume demand in this same year and hot-melt adhesives had a share of 15.8%. The use of solvent-based adhesives in Europe has been declining for some time and

this trend is forecast to continue up to 2030 as end-users switch to more environment-friendly alternatives. The rate of change will, however, be slow since the blend of performance properties offered by many solvent-based adhesives still provides the best solution for certain end-applications over the next five years. Reactive adhesive demand has seen strong growth since 2023 and they are forecast to exhibit the fastest growth rate of all adhesive types in the five years up to 2030. This growth comes from an increased demand from high-performance applications, such as the growing use of adhesives to replace mechanical fastenings in the automotive industry and in industrial assembly operations. Adhesives based on natural polymers are also forecast to see higher than the average growth from 2023 to 2030 due to an increased demand for sustainable materials.

Sealant trends

Silicone, polyurethane, and silicone-modified polymer (SMP) are the three main sealant product groups used in Europe, with shares of total volume demand in 2024 of 29%, 18.6%, and 15% respectively. Their widespread use is driven by the need for waterproofing and/or weatherproofing for many sealant end-applications. Acrylic-based sealants offer a general-purpose, low-cost option for a variety of applications and they continue to grow at around the overall average rate.

Continued...

Demand for the traditional oil-based and bitumen & pitch sealant types has been falling for over five years and this decline is forecast to continue up to 2030.

Sealants based on silane-modified polymers (also known as hybrid sealants) represent the fastest growing sealant category. With performance properties that are claimed to combine the best of silicones and polyurethanes (hence 'hybrid'), they are highly versatile sealants despite their higher cost compared to the other two types. Polyurethane sealants are also forecast to see high growth over the reporting period, while silicone sealants are forecast to see only modest growth.

Market in Great Britain (UK)

The combined volume demand for adhesives and sealants in Great Britain amounted to 425,900 tonnes in 2024, with a value of €1.5 billion. Over the period from 2023 to 2030, the volume demand is forecast to grow at 1.5% CAGR, leading to a 2030 market demand of 468,500 tonnes, with a value of €1.6 billion.

Economic growth in the UK is forecast by the IMF to be similar to that in the EU in 2025 and 2026. The UK government has negotiated a new trading arrangement with the EU that is intended to remove many of the bureaucratic hurdles imposed on the transfer of goods between both sides since Brexit. The UK government has also agreed

a deal with the USA that will reduce the impact on UK exports from the new tariff regime.

Adhesive demand in 2024 was for 358,200 tonnes at a value of €1.1 billion. Volume demand for adhesives is forecast to grow at 1.5% CAGR over the next the five years to reach a demand for 390,300 tonnes by 2030, with a value of €1.2 billion.

Paper, board & related products is the largest end-use segment for adhesives in Great Britain. The UK packaging industry, a major user of these adhesives, is having to readjust to the growing demand for sustainable packaging and reduced packaging waste. The Packaging Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) scheme, which places financial and operational responsibility on producers for the end-of-life management of packaging they place on the market, was fully implemented in 2025.

Packaging users are also under growing pressure to demonstrate that their packaging will align with evolving recycling infrastructures. This is expected to result in an increased use of sustainable packaging materials such as paper-based packaging and plant-based bioplastics.

Building and construction was the second largest segment for adhesive demand in 2024. This is forecast to grow at 2.0% CAGR in volume over the next five years as construction output rebounds from

a disappointing 2024. The residential building market is expected to revive as interest rates start to fall and government initiatives are introduced to accelerate house building programmes by reducing planning bureaucracy.

The government has also announced £725 billion in government funding for infrastructure projects over the ten years to 2035.



All adhesive categories are forecast to see growth to a greater or lesser extent over the next five years, with the exception of solvent-based adhesives. Reactive adhesives are forecast to have the fastest rate of growth to 2030 at 3.5% CAGR by volume.

Adhesives based on natural polymers are also forecast to grow faster than the overall average over the next five years as they find increased demand for packaging applications due to their environmental-friendly profile.

The first FEICA European market report was issued in 2005 and covered the period 2004–2007. In 2008, the second edition was released covering the period 2007–2010. This ninth edition covers the period 2025– 2030.






